Quickstart tennis is a new format to help kids 10 and under learn to play the game. To make it easier for them, we modified a few things. By modifying the court size, racquet size, balls, scoring system and the net height, combined with a play component, kids will develop better technical and tactical skills.

Like other popular junior sports, Quickstart stresses the importance of play and team competition. Tennis spends years teaching before juniors learn to play and you lose the window of opportunity to get them hooked on the game. Players want to play the game as soon as possible and if you look at any other sport they all get juniors playing their game quickly – that is what motivates them to improve and strive to succeed.

We are offering Quickstart Match play every Saturday and Sunday here at acac: This is not a tennis clinic this is Match play which helps you practice what you have learned in Quickstart tennis clinics.

-60' match play for kids ages 10-12 years old will be from 11:30-12:30pm

This program will be offered every Saturday and Sunday through the winter and spring at acac. We are incorporating this program into our junior tennis here at acac because we have recently put in the 36' and 60' lines on our tennis courts to encourage our kids to play Quickstart tennis. The Richmond Tennis Association has paid for a portion of our lines to help encourage all the young people in Richmond to participate in this new USTA program. We want to open up our facility to any junior who would like to participate who lives in the Richmond area.
